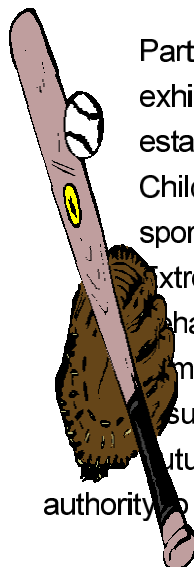
The purpose of this evaluation period is to test and rate all participants baseball/softball skills. Ratings and evaluations will be used by the Recreation Department staff to organize fair and competitive teams for each league. All players (Except T-Ball players) are required to attend their evaluation day and time! Please be on time for your scheduled slot - any late comers will have to wait.

EVALUATION FORMAT: Players will rotate from station to station and be evaluated by the Recreation/coaching staff. Players will be given a number and directions to where and what to do when they arrive. Players must report to all of the stations. The stations are: hitting, fielding ground balls and fly balls, making a throw to first base, and pitching.

ALL EVALUATIONS WILL BE HELD AT VILLAGE PARK.

After the player has been evaluated at each station, the player is done and may leave. Evaluations are confidential and are only used for the sole purpose of creating fair and equal teams.
