Notice of Water Boil Order

NOVEMBER 9, 2007

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED OF A WATER BOIL ORDER, WHICH WENT INTO EFFECT AT 10:00 A.M. ON NOVEMBER 9, 2007.

THE AREA IS INCLUSIVE OF ALL USERS ON THE 500, 600, 700, 800 AND 900 BLOCKS OF KENOSHA ROAD, AND THE 600 BLOCK OF MEADOW COURT.

DUE TO A WATER MAIN REPAIR THERE WAS A DROP IN WATER PRESSURE TO BELOW 20 PSI. ILLINOIS STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT ANY PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY MUST ISSUE A WATER BOIL ORDER NOTICE WHEN A SITUATION SUCH AS THIS OCCURS.

UNTIL WATER SAMPLE TEST RESULTS ARE RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2007, THE BOIL ORDER WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT AS A PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE.

YOU NEED TO BRING YOUR DRINKING WATER TO A BOIL FOR 5 MINUTES, BEFORE USING FOR CONSUMPTION.
